Some Special Notes about our Work Week:

- ~ Gleaning with St. Andrews on Friday will begin early in the morning and conclude before the day gets too hot. We will eat out together at no cost to volunteers.
- ~ The Habitat Work Site is on a house that is nearing completion – mostly painting, finish work inside, and landscaping. (There is no roofing to be done.) The workday will be 8:00 am – 1:00 pm at which time lunch will be served to all volunteers at no cost. There will be something for children and youth under the age of 16 to do on the project.
- ~ We are looking for folks with trucks and/or trailers to pick up produce on Saturday for the Produce Drop on Sunday.
- ~ Packaging the kits for the Haven will take place during Sunday School in the Fellowship Hall.
- ~ Those working at Salvation Army on Monday are asked to let us know which of the four activities you are interested in working on.
- ~ Everyone in the Trinity Family is invited to the Pot-Luck Supper, Reflections, and Evening Vespers on Monday, July 10, in the Fellowship Hall. It is not necessary that you work as a volunteer in order to come to the dinner that evening. We simply ask that all who come bring a dish to share.

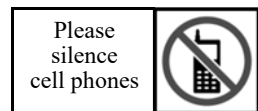

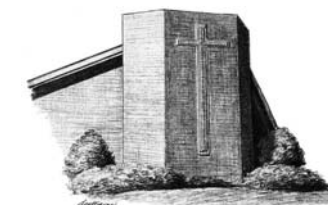
