### Washington DC Adult Mission Trip

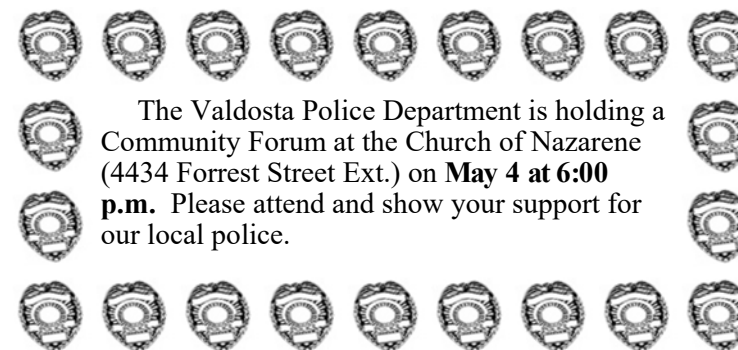

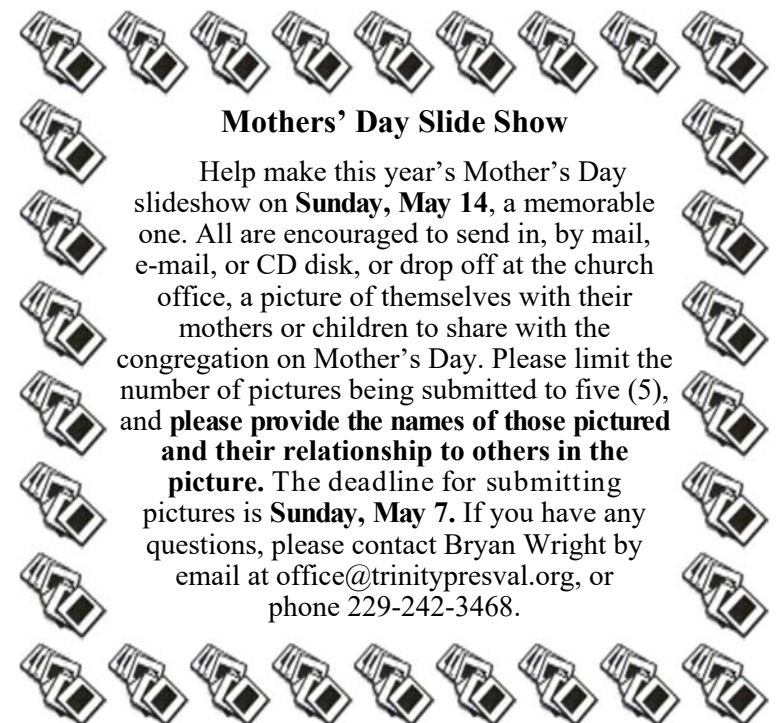

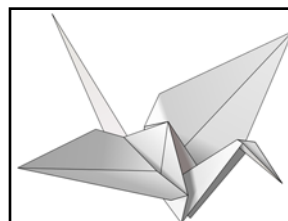

**Carry-outs – meal cost above plus 25¢ per carry-out tray available after 6:40 p.m.**

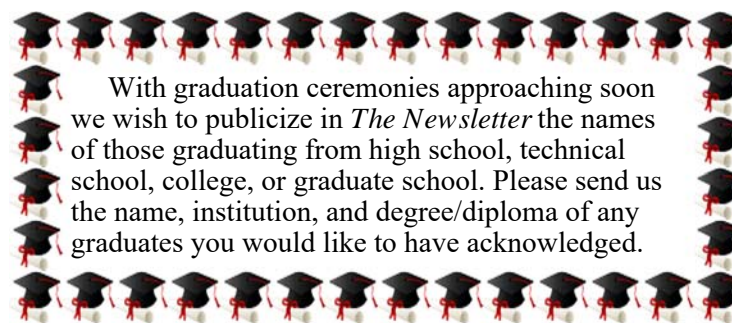
### Columbarium and Prayer Garden Construction

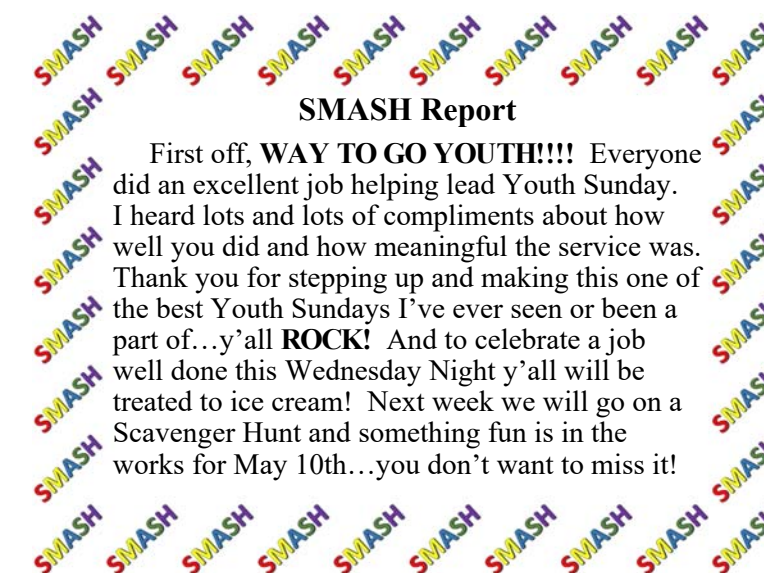
