Having fled the communal violence of Buddhist-majority Myanmar, hundreds of thousands of Muslim Rohingyas now live in Bangladesh, most in flimsy dwellings in both official and makeshift refugee camps. Lord, have mercy upon the Rohingya people, one of the most persecuted minorities in the world, and especially upon those who have now lost their homes. Grant them hope for life and peace, in the name of Christ, the Prince of Peace, we pray. Amen.

Our heavenly Father, we pray for Muktar, who, emaciated and clad in a dirty lungi and T-shirt, sits begging all day at the bottom of the steps of a footbridge over one of the mos congested and noisiest thoroughfares in Dhaka, Bangladesh. He once peddled a rickshaw for a living, but one day six years ago, while walking along the side of a road, a microbus struck him from behind, leaving him permanently debilitated. The only way he has now to feed his family and keep his two young children in school is to extend his hand for alms. He smiles in gratitude for the mercy of others. Lord, extend to him your eternal mercy, that he may know of your everlasting love, in the name of Christ the Savior we pray. Amen.
