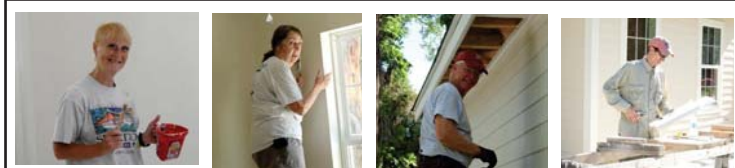

Trinity Conducts Successful Summer Mission Project

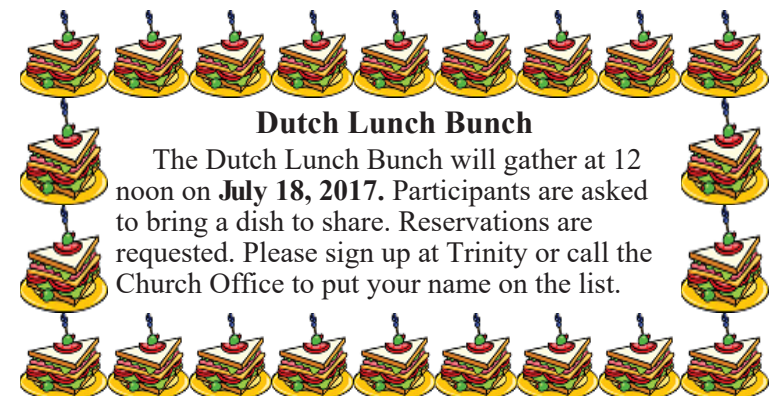
Many thanks to all who participated in and contributed in any way to the success of our five day Summer Mission Project. More than fifty (50) Trinity folks participated in assisting five different local mission organizations which serve our Lowndes County neighbors. In addition, to date we have collected nearly \$1,500 in contributions from participants and other donors. After expenses of the project we will be sending additional financial aid to each of the organizations we helped this week. Other statistics we have are as follows:

- ⇒ 125 sack lunches made and distributed at the Community Soup Kitchen
- ⇒ 15+ bushels of tomatoes gleaned with the Society of St Andrew
- ⇒ 30 volunteer hours at Habitat contributed to homeowners working on their sweat-equity hours
- ⇒ 60+ shower kits packed for The Haven
- ⇒ 35+ baby kits packed for The Haven
- ⇒ 3,000+ pounds of corn and other vegetable packed for Society of St Andrew
- ⇒ 15 men were served breakfast or dinner at the Salvation Army Men's Shelter
- ⇒ 800+ articles of clothing sorted, hung up, tagged, and racked at the Salvation Army Thrift Store

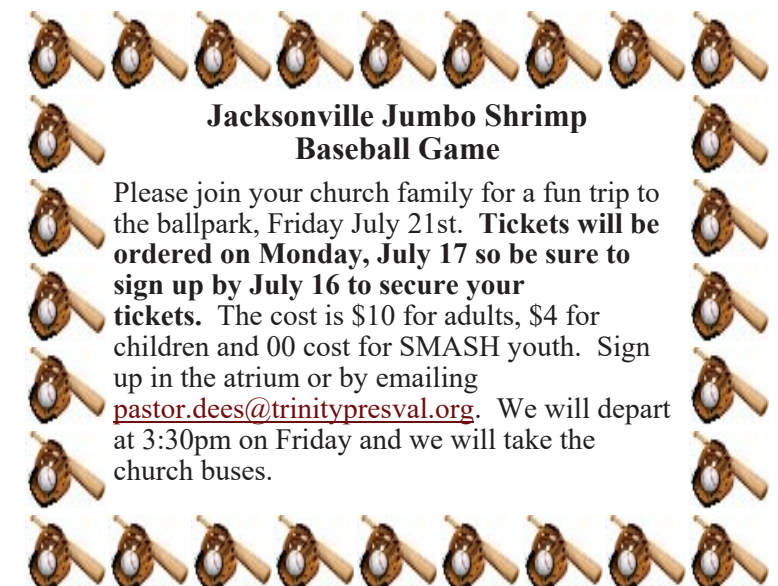
Elder Resignation

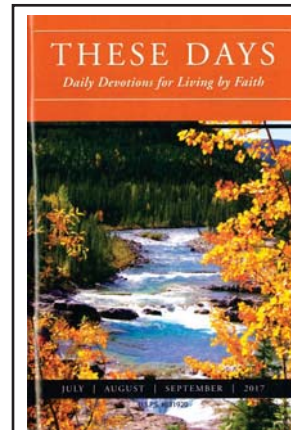
Dutch Lunch Bunch

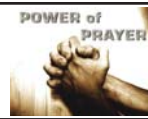


These Days Devotional Booklets

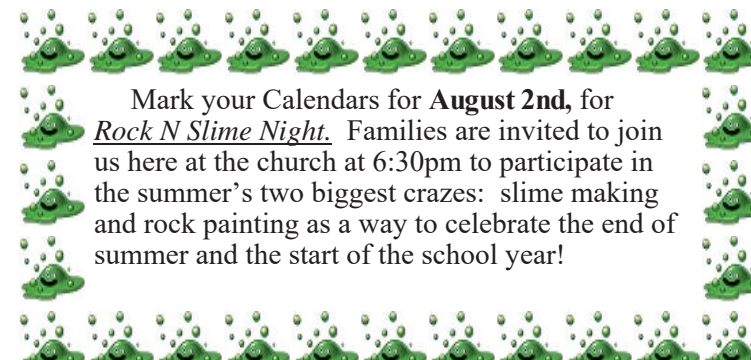
