**Dutch Lunch Bunch**

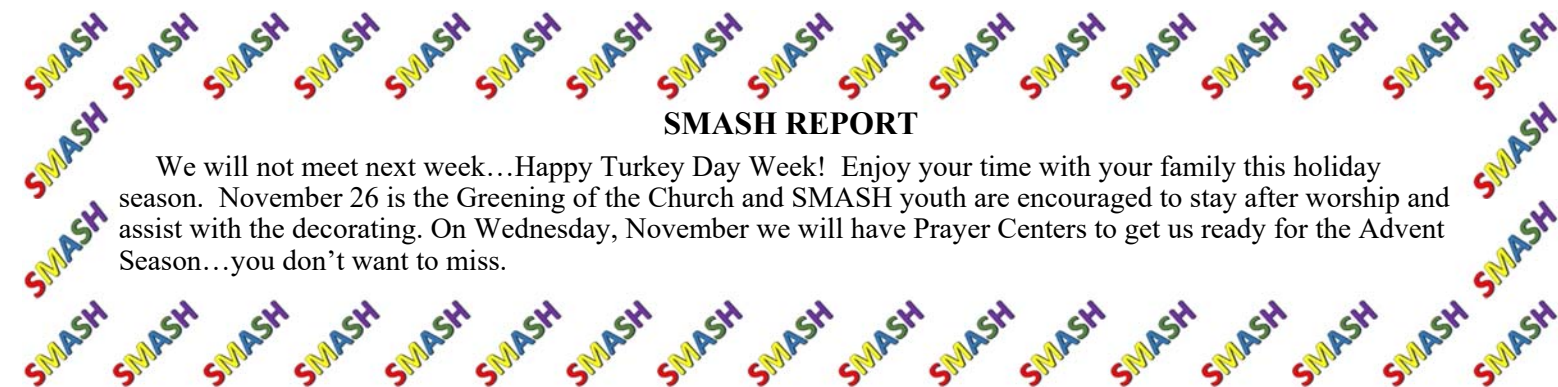
