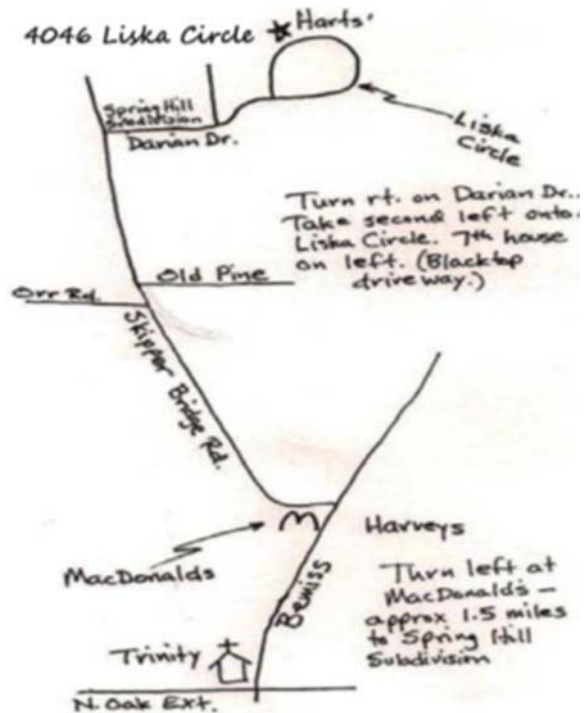


You're Invited to the Harts'

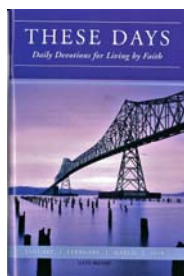


Annual Christmas Joy Offering

Traditionally throughout the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) an offering has been received during Advent for two important causes. Half of the Christmas Joy Offering will go to provide financial assistance to retired church workers and their families on limited income. Administered through the Board of Pensions these funds also assist ministers and missionaries experiencing significant emergency financial crises for themselves and their families. The other half of the offering will go to support racial ethnic schools and colleges of the PC(USA). Those receiving funds this year are the Menaul School, a Christian High School in Albuquerque, New Mexico; the Presbyterian Pan American School, an international high school in Kingland, Texas; and Stillman College in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. We will receive the Christmas Joy Offering at Trinity on **Sunday, December 17, 2017**.

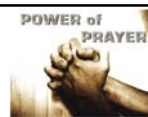


A Message from the Finance Committee
