Christmas Eve Communion and Candlelight Service

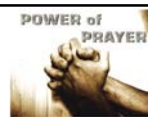

**New Year's – Monday – January 1, 2018**

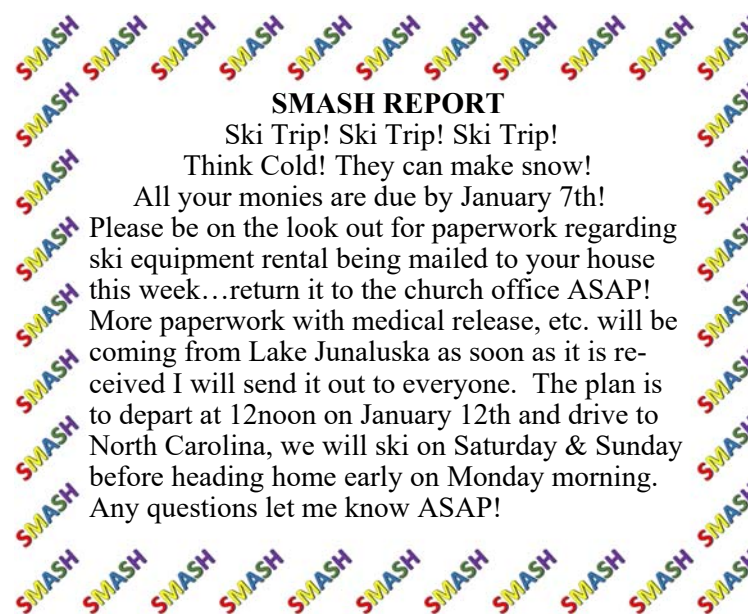

Think Cold! They can make snow!

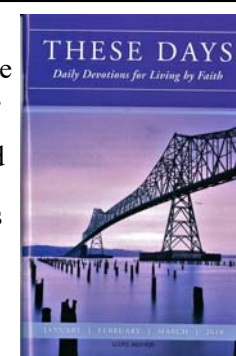
All your monies are due by January 7th!
