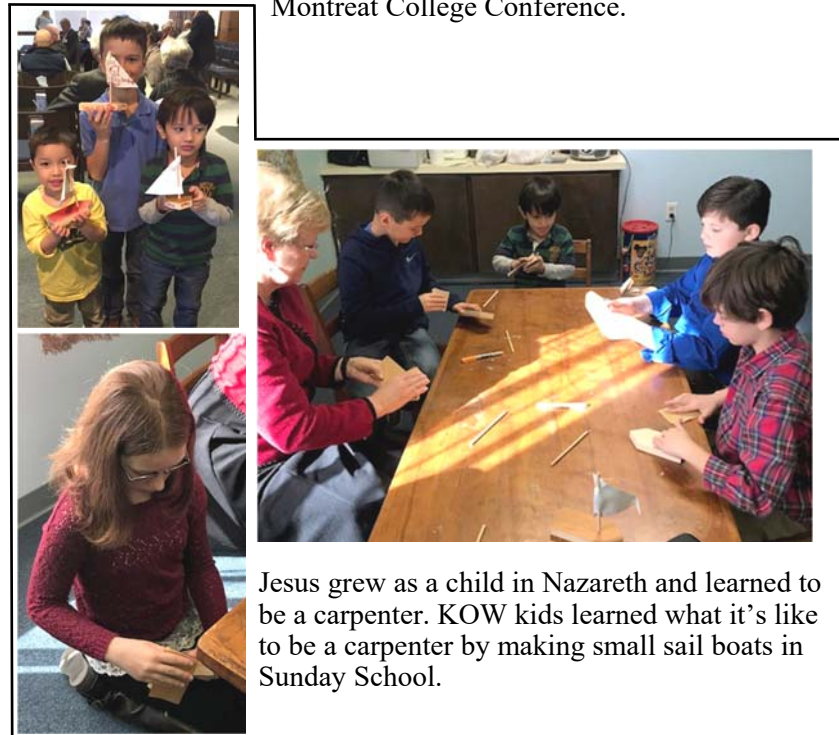

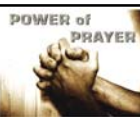


Youth Yard Sale 2018

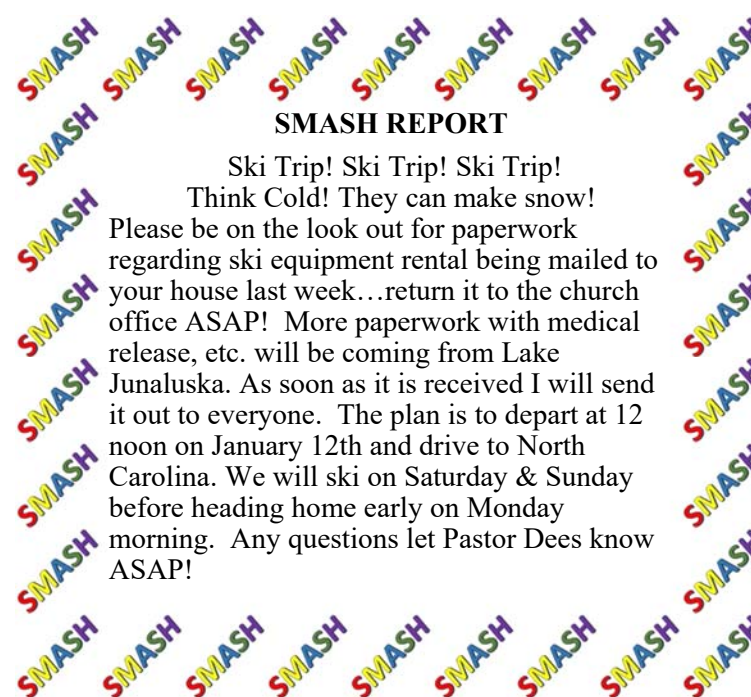

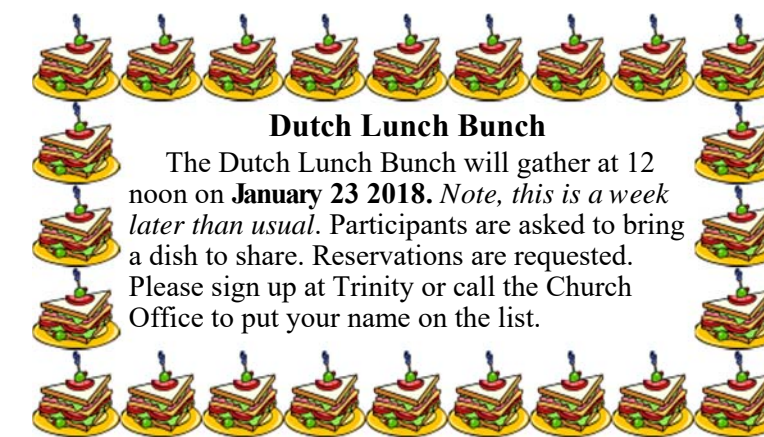


SMASH REPORT
