Saturday, June 30 – Choose one: Habitat for Humanity House Build or Gleaning Produce with Society of St Andrew.

Sunday, July 1 – Packing hygiene and baby kits for the Haven during Sunday School and Produce Drop with Society of St Andrew after worship.

Monday, July 2 - Assisting St. Barnabas Episcopal Church in packing and serving sack lunches to be distributed at the Soup Kitchen site on N. Lee Street.

Stated Session Meeting June 17

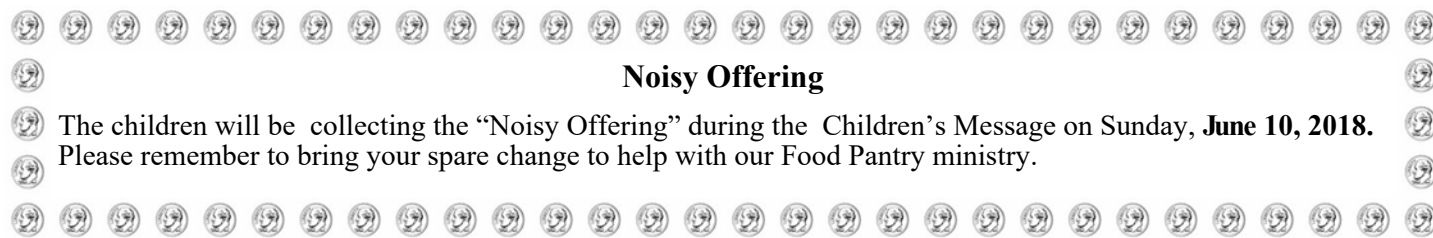
