Please place your food donations in the baskets at the sanctuary door as you enter for worship.

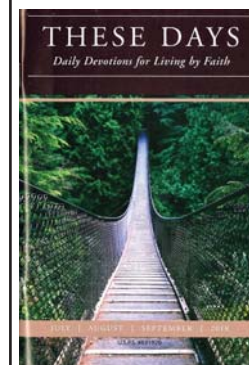
#### Commissioning our Mission Trip Youth and Adults
