Mission Statement

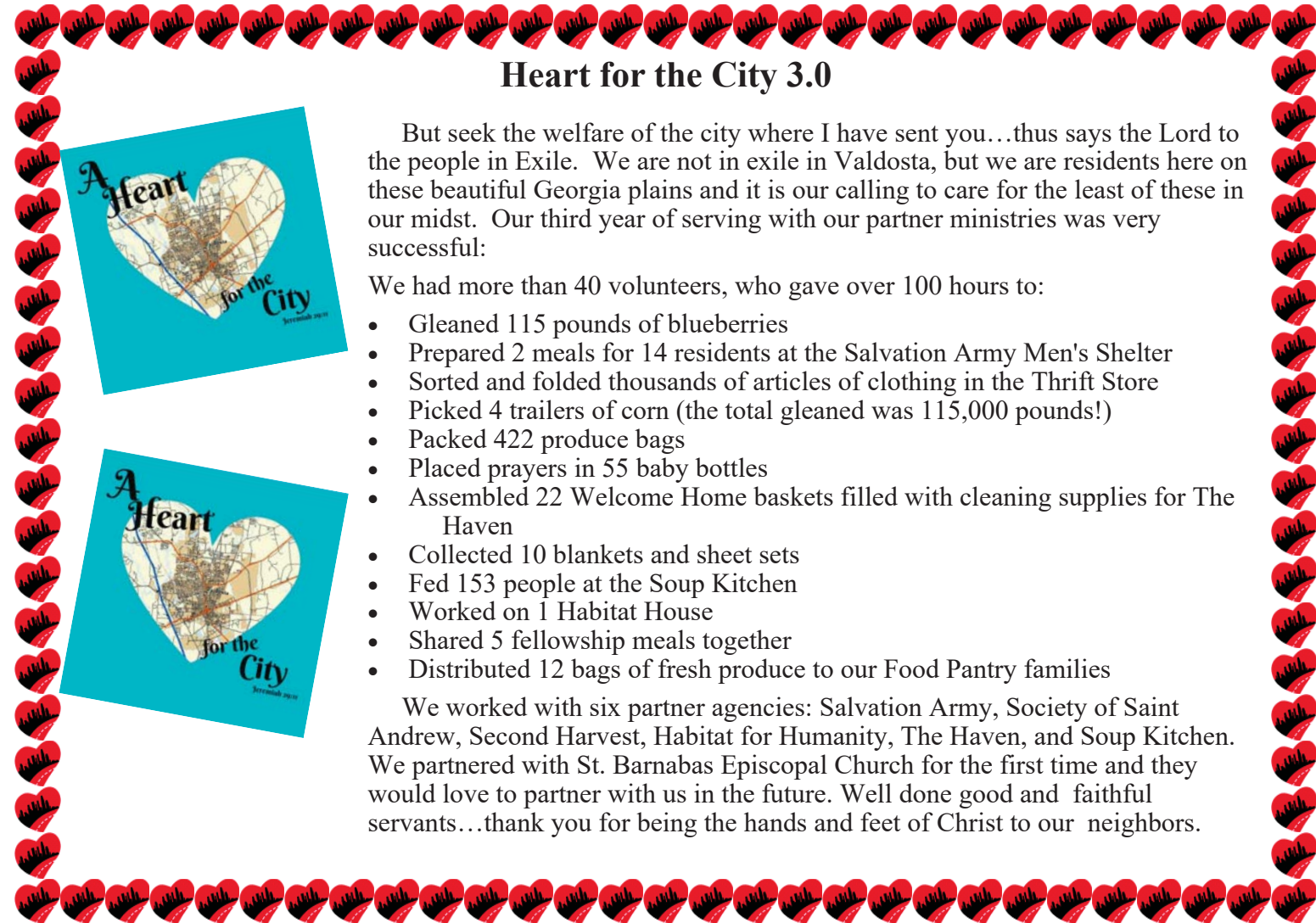
*As Believers, we will worship God by...

We are not in exile in Valdosta, but we are residents here on these beautiful Georgia plains and it is our calling to care for the least of these in our midst. Our third year of serving with our partner ministries was very successful:

We had more than 40 volunteers, who gave over 100 hours to:

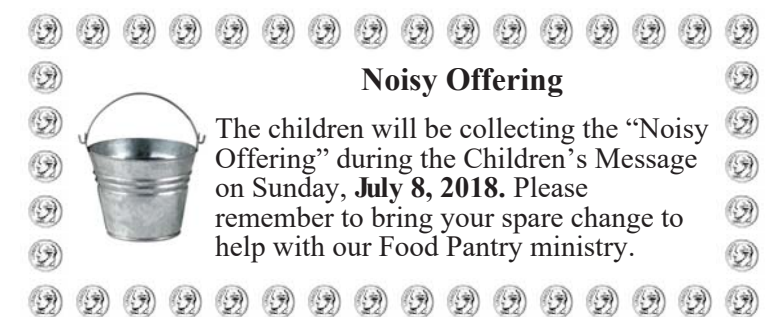
- Gleaned 115 pounds of blueberries
- Prepared 2 meals for 14 residents at the Salvation Army Men's Shelter
- Sorted and folded thousands of articles of clothing in the Thrift Store
- Picked 4 trailers of corn (the total gleaned was 115,000 pounds!)
- Packed 422 produce bags
- Placed prayers in 55 baby bottles
- Assembled 22 Welcome Home baskets filled with cleaning supplies for The Haven
- Collected 10 blankets and sheet sets
- Fed 153 people at the Soup Kitchen
- Worked on 1 Habitat House
- Shared 5 fellowship meals together
- Distributed 12 bags of fresh produce to our Food Pantry families

We worked with six partner agencies: Salvation Army, Society of Saint Andrew, Second Harvest, Habitat for Humanity, The Haven, and Soup Kitchen. We partnered with St. Barnabas Episcopal Church for the first time and they would love to partner with us in the future. Well done good and faithful servants...thank you for being the hands and feet of Christ to our neighbors.
