### Looking For a Fun Summer Competition?



#### Trinity Food Pantry Use 2025





The program began December 3, 1973, and it is funded entirely by local contributions and special events like the *Break Bread Bun Run*.™



Sponsored by First Presbyterian Church, the Bun Run will begin at 7:30 AM at the YMCA on Gornto Road and will last about an hour. If you are unable to run the race, you can still support the event as a volunteer!

Registration is open for the Break Bread Together Bun Run, the 5k road race through Old Wood Valley Subdivision on **Saturday, 7 June 2025**.


